<b>Presentation: Time</b>	Group presentation was less than 7 minutes ( <i>too short</i> ), or longer than 20 minutes ( <i>too long</i> )	Group presentation was at least 7 minutes	Group presentation was at least 10 minutes	Group presentation was at least 15 minutes
<b>Presentation: Use of Multiple Delivery Methods</b>	Did not involve the class; used only one method of delivery ( <i>EXAMPLE: lecture with no interaction</i> )	Used at least 1 alternate method of delivery; included class in discussion	Used at least 2 alternate methods of delivery; class was actively involved in discussion	Used at least 3 alternate methods of delivery; class was actively involved in discussion
<b>Presentation: Use of Examples/Scenarios to Illustrate Points</b>	Zero or 1 relevant example used	2 relevant examples used	3 or more relevant examples used; examples were of easy to moderate difficulty and required understanding of material to solve	4 or more relevant and challenging examples used; required understanding and application of material to solve, generated discussion
