W.S.C.J.T.C. Incident Report Narrative

((INTRODUCTION))

On 02-20-2014 at 1800 hours I contacted R/P Cheryl and John Jasper regarding their missing daughter, V-Corey Jasper. Cheryl and John are the parents of Corey and she is their only child.

(BODY)

According to Cheryl, they last saw Corey when she left for school on this date at about 0700 hours. Corey was last seen stepping onto her school bus heading for John Wayne High School, where she is a sophomore. According to the school, Corey was in school all day, but did not get on the bus. She should have been home by 1530. Both Cheryl and John told me that Corey has been acting up and that her grades have been getting worse since Christmas. John also told me that Corey has a new boyfriend, W-Smith and that he attends Carole King High School in the Spokane area.

Cheryl told me that she has called Corey's cell phone but that she is not answering. John said that he called Sprint (their phone company) and they were told that the phone was turned off. Cheryl was able to access the phone records and has a phone number for Smith.

I called the phone number for Smith and a male voice answered. I identified myself to the male and he asked me if I was looking for Corey Jasper. I told him that I was and I asked if she was with him. Smith said that Corey was not with him, but that he knew where she was. Smith told me that Corey was upset with her parents and that she told him that she was going to hang out at the local library and let her parents worry about her, just to get back at them.

I asked Smith when he spoke with her last and he told me about 10 minutes ago. I obtained Smith's address, DOB and other contact information for the report. I told Smith that he was not to call Corey. The library that Smith had mentioned was across town, so I asked for another officer to go to that location and look for her. I provided the officer with Corey's name and physical description.

At approximately 1830 hours I was contacted by Officer Lilly and she advised that she had located Corey at the public library and that they were returning to the house.

(CONCLUSION)

Officer Lilly arrived at the house at 1845 hours with Corey. Corey was apologetic to her parents as well as to our office. Corey said that it was a stupid thing to do and that she was sorry for the inconvenience. I discussed with Corey other ways to deal with issues and that running away and/or faking it to scare her parents was not the best solution. I suggested to all that counseling may be a good idea. It was apparent that the family was going to work on the issues and we left the residence.
