Throughout the HRVS, keep your basic principles in effect:

- Cover / Concealment
- Obtain comfortable positions, stable shooting platform
- Remember, don't crowd cover
- Contact / Cover
 - Areas of Responsibility
 - Roles may change depending on needs
 - Flexibility/smooth transition between roles
 - Maximize Advantage
 - Position / Weapons / Hands / Etc.




Session Materials

1. Prepare for the Stop

- Identify the need to do a HRVS (the who, what)
- Choose location of the stop
- Back-up if available
- Radio (dispatch / other officers)


2. Initiate the Stop


- Vehicle Positioning (street width considerations, use sidewalks, driveways etc for vehicle positioning)
- **Crossfire & Backdrop** (traffic conditions, pedestrians, nearby buildings, etc.)
- **Traffic Control** (how many, where to put them, allow other officers to place them)
- Emergency Lights & Equip.







3. Secure the Scene


- **Control Suspects Hands** (hands outside the windows remember that suspects are lazy)
- **Immobilize the Suspect Vehicle** (suspect removes keys and places them on top of vehicle)
- Angles of Exposure (suspects and officers)
- **360-Degree Awareness** (know who and what is around your position)
- **Verbal Commands** (slow down, think, clear and direct voice commands)

4. Extract and Secure Suspects

- Suspect Removal (control Hands, open door using outside handle)
- **Suspect Control** (step out, expose waistband, 360 turn with head down)
- Movement to Contact (walk backwards, trunk check/press, align threats)
- Curtain of Light/Vehicle Cover (operate behind the curtain of light, placement of suspects for cuffing)
- 100% Control (during the cuffing phase, searching/frisking phase, movement phase)



5. Clear the Suspect Vehicle

- Use Bluff
- Limit your exposure during movement
- Use cover whenever available during movement
- Remember the principles of Pie
- Areas of Responsibility, Watch for cross fire and backdrop
- As you get close to the threat, bring your weapon in closer to your body
- Do we sweep the trunk or not?
- Use cover while moving to suspect vehicle whenever possible
- Movement is only as fast as you can process information
