

UNUSUAL OCCURRENCE TACTICAL EXERCISE

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Develops teamwork, coordination, communication, cooperation, strategic thinking, and radio procedure.
- Demonstrates situational awareness, contact cover, active shooter, cover and concealment concepts.

EQUIPMENT

- Water guns, MAX OF four long guns per team
- Different colored shirts for ½ the class
- Radios
- Handcuffs
- 2 Flags

SAFETY BRIEFING

Each student will be checked for weapons prior to exercise. *No* other weapons other than water pistols are allowed.

OBJECT

Capture other team's flag and successfully bring it to your command post

Set up:

- Flag will be placed inside a building or in wooded area.
- Teams establish boundaries
- Teams establish a perimeter - no entry area within 20 feet of their own flag
- Each team sends a scout to view location of flag and report back to team
- ***Each team writes and submits an operation plan*** to monitor for approval prior to game.
- Each team sets up command post (consider you will need a refill area for water pistols)

CAPTURE

Only a torso or head shot with water pistol is a capture. If you are shot, you will IMMEDIATELY stop and become compliant. The other team can take your weapon. You will immediately go to a regenerate spot and then return to your command post before re-entering game. You will be without a weapon until one of your teammates supplies you with one.

UNUSUAL OCCURRENCE TACTICAL EXERCISE

RULES

- No physical touching.
- No take downs!
- NO damaging property!
- No OVERACTING!
- BE SAFE! AVOID INJURY!
- Listen to monitor, action stops if whistle is blown.
- Stay in woods.
- No out of bounds movement.
- No movement on streets.
- No visibility to surrounding houses.
- Move only in pairs or more.
- DO NOT CLIMB on top of buildings or trees.
- No cars!
- No hitching rides.
- No hoses.
- HAVE FUN BUT REMEMBER THIS IS FOR TRAINING - LEARN SOMETHING FROM IT!
