

It is from the procedures manual, section 22.0 SMART Procedure, page 253.

If there is any doubt as to whether a particular incident would meet the criteria for SMART deployment, the on-scene supervisor should, after notifying the on-duty lieutenant (or Operations Duty Officer – ODO) as and with authorization from the Command Duty Officer (CDO), request consultation with a SMART commander via SNOPAC.

I've read it a couple times and am not sure I understand it. Particularly when the activation info in the next paragraph is considered.

The on-duty lieutenant or ODO will consult with the CDO prior to a request for activation. After reviewing the circumstances of an incident involving Everett Police personnel, the CDO may then authorize the on-scene supervisor to request a SMART activation.
